Today's "Commerce Trade Treaty concludes the releasing of the Treaties that were signed by the member Nations/Tribes of the Federation of Aboriginal Nations of the Americas (FANA) at the Providence Cultural Equity Initiative's fifth Annual International Indigenous Peoples Cultural Conference held at Roger Williams University Baypoint Conference Center in Bristol, Rhode Island held on April 18, 2021.

Today's document establishes the Commerce and Trade Treaty amongst the international FANA Tribal members; thereby creating the largest commerce and trade Treaty amongst the indigenous Peoples in modern times.

Principal Chief Dr Ronald Yonaguska Holloway of the Sandhill Band of Lenape and Cherokee Indians is a founding member of FANA and its International Ambassador.

Also attached is the Montaup Treaty which takes FANA and its Tribal Members from the national arena into the International arena of influence.

Over the next few months both FANA and the SandHills will be releasing treaties and documents going from the East Coast through the Polynesian Kingdom; and from the East Coast through Europe; and to the interior of Africa, forming the largest Confederacy of Indigenous Peoples and Allies in modern times.
