OFFICIAL INTERNATIONAL INDIGENOUS NATION TO NATION TREATY OF "COMMERCE AND TRADE"

This Official International Indigenous Nation to Nation Treaty of "Commerce and Trade" is now established between the undersigned Sovereign International Indigenous Member Nations comprising the International Confederation known as the Federation of Aboriginal Nations of the Americas (FANA), hereafter the FANA Member Nations; and is signed by the Sovereign or the Principal Chief or the officially authorized representative or delegate of each FANA Member Nation comprising this International Confederation.

This Official International Indigenous Nation to Nation Treaty of "Commerce and Trade" is established in a truthful, respectful, dignified and honorable manner that promotes goodness, honesty, righteousness, equity and love in the spirit, traditions, and ways that the Great Spirit, the Creator of All Living Things, our ancestors and our elders have always respected and continue to keep.

This Official International Indigenous Nation to Nation Treaty of "Commerce and Trade" is formed between the FANA Member Nations with the specific objectives of

strengthening the special bonds of friendship and cooperation among the FANA Member Nations;

creating and expanding more secure markets for the goods and services produced in their territories;

eliminating barriers to trade in and facilitating the cross-border movement of goods and services between the territories of the FANA Member Nations;

establishing, confirming, securing, and protecting the right of free, safe, and efficient cross-border travel between the territories of the FANA Member Nations through both traditional and contemporary routes and modes of travel;

promoting conditions of fair competition;

increasing investment opportunities in the territories of the FANA Member Nations;

reducing distortions to trade;

establishing clear and mutually advantageous rules governing trade between the FANA Member Nations;

ensuring a predictable commercial framework for business planning and investment;

enhancing the competitiveness of the firms of the FANA Member Nations in global markets;

fostering creativity and innovation, and promoting trade in goods and services that are the subject of intellectual property rights;

creating new employment opportunities that improve working conditions and living standards in the respective territories of the FANA Member Nations;

preserving the flexibility of the FANA Member Nations to safeguard the public welfare;

promoting sustainable development;

strengthening the development and enforcement of cultural, tribal, customary, and traditional environmental laws and regulations of the FANA Member Nations;

protecting, enhancing, and enforcing the basic rights of workers;

creating effective procedures for the implementation and application of this Official International Indigenous Nation to Nation Treaty of "Commerce & Trade" to ensure its joint administration and for the resolution of disputes that may arise;

establishing a framework for further regional and multilateral cooperation to expand and enhance the benefits of this Agreement and building on the respective rights and obligations of the FANA Member Nations under the Official International Indigenous Nation to Nation Treaties of "Peace and Friendship" and "Health and Wellness" and the "Treaty of Montaup"; and

undertaking each of the preceding in a manner that is respectful of the traditional and cultural norms, values, beliefs and customary laws of the FANA Member Nations and that protects the integrity of the FANA Member Nations as was intended by the Great Spirit, the Creator of All Living Things.

All provisions of this Official International Indigenous Nation to Nation Treaty of "Commerce and Trade" shall serve as the framework, foundation, and barometer for the establishment of future commerce and trade related treaties, agreements, collaborations, and partnerships between the FANA Member Nations and will be conducted in a manner and spirit of perpetual truth, honesty, and righteousness that seeks to and does serve the mutual interest and benefit of all the FANA Member Nations, and also ensures integrity and transparency, through the utilization of appropriate current and future technologies and technological advances, so that the Great Spirit, the Creator of All Living Things, our good spirits, and our dearly departed ancestors will honor and respect this agreement and covenant.

Upon confirmation of this Official International Indigenous Nation to Nation Treaty of "Commerce and Trade" the FANA Member Nations shall immediately establish a working committee to research, identify, and develop appropriate policies and provisions to be amended to this Official International Indigenous Nation to Nation Treaty of "Commerce and Trade" which shall be related but not limited to anticompetitive business conduct, monopolies, state enterprise, essential security interests, taxation measures, tax conventions, disclosure, competition law enforcement, trade in goods, technical barriers to trade, cross-border travel, government procurement, investment, services and related matters, commodities, intellectual property, administrative and institutional provisions, and any other subject matter or advancements that is deemed necessary and appropriate for achieving the objectives previously expressed in this Official International Indigenous Nation to Nation Treaty of "Commerce and Trade."

This Official International Indigenous Nation to Nation Treaty of "Commerce and Trade" shall enter into force immediately upon signature confirmation by the FANA Member Nations.

May the Creator bless and approve of this Official International Indigenous Nation to Nation Treaty of "Commerce and Trade" and may each of the FANA Member Nations share, uphold, and protect the sanctity, integrity, and authority of this Official International Indigenous Nation to Nation Treaty of "Commerce and Trade" with and for one another in an equitable, righteous, respectful, and honorable manner and spirit for as long as the sun does rise, and the rivers and the oceans do exist.

For the mutual benefit and in the interest of all of the FANA Member Nations is this Official International Indigenous Nation to Nation Treaty of "Commerce and Trade" signed this Eighteenth Day of the Month of April of the Year Two Thousand Twenty-One of the Gregorian Calendar.
